### Growing Spiritual Fruit and Dying Spiritual Fruit

Recently God has had me ministering on the subject of “Growing Spiritual Fruit and Dying Spiritual Fruit”.

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,  
Gal 5:23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

The fruits listed here are of course not the fruit of the Holy Spirit but rather the innate fruit of the human spirit that each of us received when we are born again.

Although each of these fruit come fully installed and fully operational at an adult level in our spirits at the rebirth they are not automatically transferred over into the realm of the soul at the same time.

All of these fruit absolutely have the potential to be fully operational in our minds and emotions the moment that we are saved. The only problem is that each of these fruit must be transferred through CHOICE. We must choose to live after the person we became on the inside in our spirits at the moment of spiritual conception.

We must remember that there is always a choice between living after the spirit and after the flesh. If the right choices are continually made we are allowing the life that is in our spirit to transfer to the outward limbs of the soul. When this happens the fruit of the born-again spirit will be exhibited and enjoyed by both the individual believer and everyone around him. This is called spiritual growth or maturity.

The first fruit listed in Galatians 5:22 is the fruit of love. When the God kind of love (Agape) that every believer receives at salvation is allowed to be transferred through choice to the outward limbs of the soul wonderful things take place.

When the love of God lives and manifest in the realm of the soul just like it does in the spirit then compassion is exhibited.

Compassion will cause a believer to forget about their own needs (while resting in God) and begin to focus on being a minister of life and love to others.

Compassion transfers from a focus of “What about me” into an attitude of “what is my father’s desire for me to minister in the needs for others”?

The fruit of love is compassion and I think God for people like you who are being filled with God’s passion for the lost and hungry in this world. This is what the atmosphere of revival looks like.
