The Purging Has Changed Us

Dear Friend,

Recently, God said something very peculiar in one of our services through a prophetic word. He said:

Drink of Me So They May Drink of You

Prophecy210822 – August 22, 2021

“In the reverse of what Samson knew – when he had gone out from the presence of the Lord, or My presence had departed from him, and he knew not that that presence was gone. And he shook himself as in times before. And he did not recognize that I had left, and My anointing had left him – so now in the reverse, many have come into a place where My presence has brought them through the fire, and is bringing them through a place. And there has been a change from glory to glory to glory, by My presence, says the Lord. And if you will stir yourself even now, and if you will shake yourself even now in these days, for the works that I have for you, you will find that more glory has come upon you. And those who drink of the glory that is on you and in you will be satisfied. For I desire to draw all men unto Me, says the Spirit of Grace.”

If you know the story of Samson in the book of Judges chapters 13 through 16, then you know that Samson was a judge in Israel during the occupation of the Philistines. If there ever was a picture of God’s power working through an individual without a righteous character, it was Samson.

Samson had loads of supernatural power, yet very little Godly character. Even though God used Samson greatly to free Israel from the Philistine occupation and dominion, He did it through a sovereign gift that He had given to a man who eventually lost his anointing.

Samson slowly changed through continually giving himself to the world, or we might say, the lust of the flesh. You might say that he went from glory to glory to glory in the opposite direction, until there was no real glory of God on his life left. And he didn’t even know until it was too late!

BUT, the reverse of that story is happening presently in the Revival churches and Revival people like yourself. God has been changing us especially in the last two years to a place of glory that, for the most part, we have not yet fully recognized.

A true transformation has been taking place through what He has called a purging process – a wall of fire, and a call to come away with Him into a place of intimacy. For those in His body who have been engaged in this process, even to any true conscious degree, something beyond our recognition has been taking place.

The purging process and His presence has been changing us from who we were, to the person who will be used tremendously in this Last Day Harvest, what we call Revival. Your desires have been changing. Your “want tos” have been changing. Your spiritual cravings have been changing from a place of passivity towards God, to a place of desperation for God. Your aspirations, goals, and the things that you desire to do have been changing. The world that you once knew inside of you has been changing to fit His desires. The universe inside each of us that once centered so much around ourselves has been slowly changing to finally and properly center around Him (Jesus).

Until this recent purging process, you may have been like me. I may have sworn on a stack of Bibles that my whole world centered around Jesus. And that was partially true, but because of this beautiful work of grace that has been working in all of us, my universe has drastically changed.

Whatever things that may have satisfied our appetites for life in the past have changed to where nothing but intimacy with Jesus and the Father can fill that void on the inside.

Remember that nothing, and I mean nothing, can be allowed to replace the place that Jesus should hold in our life. Every person is different in the areas they have allowed replacement of His Lordship in their life in the past. I could give a list of many different things and yet never touch yours, but some of these touch all of us:

- Television
- Sports
- Hobbies
- Jobs and career
- Marriage
- Children and family
- Courtship
- Ministry
- Vacations
- Buying, building, or remodeling a home
- Personal projects
- Exercise and working out
- Getting married
- Making money for the Kingdom of God

None of these things are sins in and of themselves, and none have to be totally abandoned to make Jesus the Lord of your life. But everything must come under His absolute dominion. Many of these things can be sanctified, and some of them can even be given directly from God, but always remember that something that was originally sanctified or given by God can turn into an

idol if it replaces the time you should be giving to Him in prayer and obedience to His call. This was the parable in Luke 14. The original people that were called to the feast in this parable had appetites or fixations on other things that created excuses for why they could not attend. In simplicity, they had no craving for the Lord's supper because their cravings were being satisfied by something else other than Him.

Luk 14:16 Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many:

Luk 14:17 And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.

Luk 14:18 And they all with one *consent* began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

Luk 14:19 And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

Luk 14:20 And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.

Luk 14:21 So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.

Luk 14:22 And the servant said, Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room.

Luk 14:23 And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled.

Luk 14:24 For I say unto you, That none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper.

There are at least two types of vision in the human eye. One is called fixation vision, which is the thing that you're focusing on at the time. I like to call this "apple vision" because God refers to us as "the apple of His eye" more than once in the Old Testament. The apple of the eye, or pupil, has often been referred to in poetry as the thing of focus.

Psa 17:8 Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings.

The eye also has the capacity for what is called peripheral vision. This is the ability to see things from a side vision which you are not focusing on, and yet can still be seen. In essence, we can see things and make allowances for them, but they are not our focus. This is what has been happening to the Church, which is becoming God's Harvest Army. We have been refocusing our vision on Jesus instead of all the things that once ruled our life and time. There is a sentence in the Blueprint for 2020 Prophecies in which the Lord said, "I say unto you that your entire life is to be consumed in Me, says the Lord. Give unto Me what brass and what silver cannot – I desire the fruit of the earth. I desire a great harvest, says the Spirit of the Lord."

The reverse of the Samson story has been happening to us in the midst of this purging process. We have been changing and yet not fully recognizing what has been happening. More anointing, more boldness, and more faith for service in His kingdom has been coming on us. And now it's time to stir and shake ourselves with a complete resolve to go all the way and complete the purging process. It's time to let the last of whatever competes with Him be stripped from us forever.

Something has changed! The anointing that has come through this season has taken the starch out of ministry outside of the church setting. I recently have had at least two opportunities to minister to people who would not normally be considered as churchgoers, and one was in a public place of business. I am not an evangelist who looks for opportunities to chase someone down to share the Gospel, but I am learning how to follow this anointing. In both cases, the opportunity and the ministry just felt so natural. The presence of God that came in both instances took away any fear of the moment, and those who were prayed for became part of that presence. It became so easy that all I can say is, it felt natural.

The Revival is now! And it's worldwide! It's not coming, it is here! It will increase with velocity and intensity. More outstanding miracles will increase the further and faster it goes, but make no mistake about it – Revival is here!

Stir yourself and shake yourself in the spirit. You will find that the reverse of the Samson story has happened. The glory of God has increased expeditiously, and you probably didn't even know it! Ha!
