Expectations

There is a question that Heaven is asking all of us right now. What are we expecting from God?

Over 4,000 years ago during a long, dark night, over 1 million Israelites sat huddled in each of their homes. They were waiting for the sun to come up. Their expectations were running wild at the possibilities of what the morning would bring. They had no idea how powerful this night would be. All they knew was that Moses had instructed them to spend the night covered with the blood of the Passover lamb on their door posts. He had also instructed them to be in a physically dressed posture of expectation. The expectation was that they would soon be on the move. They would soon be free from over 400 years of Egyptian bondage.

That same night, they also ate the Passover lamb. This was the very lamb whose blood was on the door posts and lintels of their homes. This lamb's blood spoke prophetically of God's Lamb (The Christ) who would come one day to set the world free from sin.

Exo 12:7 And they shall take of the blood, and strike *it* on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

Exo 12:8 And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; *and* with bitter *herbs* they shall eat it.

Exo 12:9 Eat not of it raw, nor sodden at all with water, but roast *with* fire; his head with his legs, and with the purtenance thereof.

Exo 12:10 And ye shall let nothing of it remain until the morning; and that which remaineth of it until the morning ye shall burn with fire.

Exo 12:11 And thus shall ye eat it; *with* your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it *is* the LORD'S passover.

Exo 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I *am* the LORD.

Amazingly enough for these Hebrews, not only did the blood of the lamb deliver them from the death angel, but something else resulted as well. The Bible tells us that as they departed, there were no feeble (or sick) among them. Their freedom from sickness and disease was also a part of their deliverance.

Psa 105:36 He smote also all the firstborn in their land, the chief of all their strength.

Psa 105:37 He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and *there was* not one feeble *person* among their tribes.

Psa 105:38 Egypt was glad when they departed: for the fear of them fell upon them.

These Israelites were commanded to dress, eat, and act with an absolute expectation that something was about to happen for them from God. They stayed up all night fully dressed, with their shoes on their feet and their walking staffs in their hands. They were getting ready to go somewhere they had never been before. They did not eat their meal slowly in a relaxed atmosphere, but rather, they ate it in haste as if there was no time to spare.

Exo 12:11 And thus shall ye eat it; *with* your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it *is* the LORD'S passover.

If we fast forward thousands of years, we know that the true Passover Lamb (Jesus the Christ) came in the dark of the world's sinful night. He came and was crucified, killed, buried, resurrected, and ascended to the Father for our deliverance from sin and sickness.

How great was this deliverance? What are we to expect from it? Are we as Christians just to sit passively every day in a neutralized posture with no expectation of the miraculous, with no expectation of the outpouring of His Spirit that has been promised prophetically, both in the scriptures and by present-day prophecies? Or should we be preparing ourselves daily with a posture of expectation for a spiritual explosion that is beginning to take our planet for the harvest of souls? Shouldn't we be praying like, talking like, and living like something is about to happen in the next minute? We should live and act like every moment holds an expectation of the miraculous. Every church service is expected to never be the same again. Every time we meet, we should presently expect not a coming Revival, but a now Revival of God's presence and miracles like we have never seen before. We can't afford to talk about what is coming. We have to believe that it is here, now! The night is far spent and the dawn is here. Now is the time to believe for the supernatural to be in our midst like never before.

Luk 12:35 Let your loins be girded about, and *your* lights burning;

Luk 12:36 And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding; that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately.

Luk 12:37 Blessed *are* those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.

There is a return of Christ presently among us. It is not His physical return, which will happen one day in the future, but it is His spiritual return in power by the Holy Ghost. It is not sovereign, but rather, it has been prayed into existence through His revivalists in the earth. What are we to expect?

Eph 3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,
