We Will Sing to Our Captors – June Letter 2023

Dear Friend,

The Church of our Lord Jesus Christ, although freed by His blood, has been held captive for many generations. The powerlessness of its approach to the world has spoken volumes of its captivity. The church at best is hardly a phantom in power and glory compared to the first church. The watered-down teachings of Jesus by His ministers has given way to the doctrines of man. Religion took the Church captive, replaced power with programs, and the world joined in on the celebration of its bondage.

The Holy Ghost cannot show up on any given Sunday in most churches to bring a demonstration of power that would result in a harvest of souls because in doing so, He would only validate the pitiful state of much of the Church.

BUT THERE IS HOPE! ALL OF THIS IS PRESENTLY CHANGING.

The following Psalm describes where the Church is at today, and its coming Day of Deliverance.

Psa 137:1 By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion.

Psa 137:2 We hanged our harps upon the willows in the midst thereof.

Psa 137:3 For there they that carried us away captive required of us a song; and they that wasted us *required of us* mirth, *saying*, Sing us *one* of the songs of Zion.

Psa 137:4 How shall we sing the LORD'S song in a strange land?

Psa 137:5 If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget *her cunning*.

Psa 137:6 If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy.

Psa 137:7 Remember, O LORD, the children of Edom in the day of Jerusalem; who said, *Rase it, rase it, even* to the foundation thereof.

Psa 137:8 O daughter of Babylon, who art to be destroyed; happy *shall he be*, that rewardeth thee as thou hast served us.

Psa 137:9 Happy *shall he be*, that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones.

Psalm 137 is an account of when the Babylonians took Israel into captivity for 70 years. The Babylonians not only destroyed Jerusalem, but they plundered the Temple of Solomon which was the holy place of worship. To make matters even worse, when they brought Israel to Babylon, they heckled them by requiring them to sing songs of joy and worship in the midst of their captivity.

It's one thing to be decimated, it's another thing to be desecrated. The Babylonians were assuring themselves that they would destroy all hope in the hearts of God's people by jeering them in the midst of their suffering.

Today, Satan is saying, “Where is YOUR REVIVAL?” “Where is your God of power and demonstration?” “Where is the massive Harvest which has been prophesied by the book of Joel?” “Where is this ‘gospel of power’ that Jesus said would be preached to the entire earth before His coming?” Satan is heckling the Revivalist Church by saying, “Sing to us your songs of joy and worship in the midst of what appears as powerlessness and no threat of Revival.”

The Psalmist said that Israel’s neighboring country of Edom joined in the heckling in the day of their destruction. The Edomites said, “Rase it, rase it, even to the foundation thereof.” The word “rase” in the Hebrew means to destroy. The Edomites were, of a sort, clapping their hands and cheering and saying, “Yes, destroy Jerusalem, even to its foundations.” But the Psalmist said, “Lord, don’t forget what they did when you turn our captivity.”

The Psalmist also cried out that God would not allow His people to forget the joy of Jerusalem even in the midst of their torment. The Revivalist Church cannot forget the joy that is set before us. We cannot lose hope in the greater promises that have been set before us in God’s Word. We must trust these promises greater than anything that we can presently see or feel. We cannot forget our spiritual Jerusalem.

Here’s our joy!! All while the Babylonians were heckling Israel, THE CLOCK WAS TICKING! Jeremiah the prophet had already prophesied before Israel’s captivity of their deliverance. They would return once again to the joy of their salvation.

The Church once again will portray the glory of the former church, and even greater. The Psalmist prophesied that the same destruction the Babylonians had brought would be brought upon them.

We will take our harps off the willows and sing to our captors! Jesus is coming in power and glory. This Revival will take place. We will not lose hope, but we will see the end result.

The Babylonians were eventually conquered and destroyed by the Persians which resulted in King Cyrus setting Israel free to go back and rebuild their worship place in Jerusalem. What I find amusing is that all while the Babylonians were tormenting Israel by saying, “Sing to us your songs of praise in your captivity,” the clock was ticking towards Israel’s deliverance!

Here’s our song in the midst of what has been the captivity of the Church, as in being destitute of its former glory. This song is being sung in the hearts of every revivalist who stands in hope of a spiritual outpouring. We will sing it loud and strong in the midst of adversity. We will sing it loud and strong to the demonic forces that would heckle God’s promises. We will sing it loud and strong to the WOKE CHURCH that has joined forces with the world. We will sing it loud and strong to the forces that say there is no hope for America. The song may not have any particular rhyme, rhythm, or melody, but it resonates with this message:
