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My Grace Is Sufficient – October Letter 2025

Dear Friend,

The apostle Paul, who is attributed with 13 books of the New Testament and possibly the book of Hebrews, is without argument one of the foremost figures of the New Testament Church.

Paul was not only known for his writings that gave sound doctrine to an infant and growing church, but also for his evangelism to the Gentile world.

Paul was originally called Saul, but Jesus Himself appeared to Saul at his conversion and changed Saul to Paul, a new man. Paul would never be the same again. He turned instantly from Judaism to Christianity in a matter of minutes and lived the rest of his life as a disciple of Jesus Christ (Acts 9). Nothing can change a man or woman like a direct encounter with Jesus. For the next nearly 40 years, Paul traveled his known part of the world preaching and teaching the gospel of the Kingdom of God. Paul's mandate was to teach the Gentiles how to live a righteous life in Christ Jesus after turning from idolatry to Christianity. Much of the history of his ministry is recorded in the latter half of the book of Acts by his traveling companion Luke the Physician.

After his conversion, Paul would go on to have many spiritual encounters with Jesus and experience angelic interventions. Paul not only received revelation knowledge but walked in the miracle working power of God. When he ministered at Ephesus for a period of about two years, incredible miracles took place through Paul. Clothing that Paul touched was sent throughout Asia and miracles of healing and deliverance of all kinds took place.

Acts 19:11 And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:

Acts 19:12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

These kinds of miracles were comparable to the miracles that Peter was used in on the streets of Jerusalem when the proximity of his shadow would heal the sick laid along the path where Peter walked.

Acts 5:14 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.

Acts 5:15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid *them* on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

Acts 5:16 There came also a multitude *out* of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Paul himself acknowledged that he shared an anointing that was not behind any of the other apostles, and this of course included Peter.

2 Corinthians 11:5 For I suppose I was not a whit behind the very chiefest apostles.

You might think that a man who walked so closely to Jesus in revelation and miracles would never come to a place of exasperation, and yet we have in his own words a record of the place where Paul cried out in utter frustration for Christ's supernatural intervention.

2 Corinthians 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.

2 Corinthians 12:8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me.

The word "thorn" in verse 7 in the original Greek depicts a pointed piece of wood or splinter, and the word "buffet" means to strike with the fist. So, Paul was saying that Satan had sent a special messenger (a devil) assigned to his life for the purpose of trying to stop Paul through multiple spiritual attacks.

The Classic Amplified version gives us a good picture of Paul's explanation of why Satan would try to stop him.

Amplified

[7] And to keep me from being puffed up and too much elated by the exceeding greatness (preeminence) of these revelations, there was given me a thorn (a splinter) in the flesh, a messenger of Satan, to rack and buffet and harass me, to keep me from being excessively exalted.

The warfare that Paul was facing from this messenger from Hell was intricately defined in the previous chapter as persecutions in Paul's life everywhere he went. When Paul cried out for help, this was the answer he got from Jesus.

2 Corinthians 12:9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Please note that Jesus did not tell Paul that His grace was INSUFFICIENT, but rather SUFFICIENT. The word "grace" here is to be understood as the supernatural empowerment of strength in the time of trouble.

Jesus was not just telling Paul to endure and suffer through the tribulation, but rather to rise up above it through a supernatural empowerment called "HIS GRACE!" Jesus was telling Paul, "I'm sending you into the world and I cannot stop Satan from coming against you, but the 'GATES OF HELL' (Matthew 16:18) will not prevail against you as long as you know that you are empowered always with My strength!" Paul actually came to full joy once he realized the revelation of what Jesus was saying.

2 Corinthians 12:10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

Believe it or not, when Paul realized that it was a matter of him humbling himself and switching his dependency from his flesh to a dependency on God's grace, he actually began to enjoy his trials by watching God's grace always be available for him.

You may think of yourself as a believer that is far less valuable than the apostle Paul, but that is absolutely not true! The least of all in the Body of Christ is extremely valuable to our Lord. You may think that only people like Paul are worthy to be fought against by Satan, but that is also a lie!

You and I have been called as END-TIME HARVESTERS FOR CHRIST'S KINGDOM! You and I have been called to see miracles flow from our hands like water! You and I have been called to witness the greatest outpouring of God's Spirit that this planet has ever seen! You and I have been called to perform miracles as easy as the breath that we breathe. Breathing is an involuntary action of the body. Miracles will be an involuntary action of our daily lives! We will perform them without thought!

Believe me, the trials that are in your life now are not natural, but supernatural. They are coming from another source, and it is not God. But every trial has a shelf life, and every trial has an end once you begin to employ the grace of God sufficiently.

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

1 Peter 5:9 Whom resist steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

1 Peter 5:10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.

1 Peter 5:11 To him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Recently, God brought back into my life an old prophecy that became new. We are adding that prophecy at the close of this letter and corresponding confessions that you can add to your stand of faith.

Candy and I love and appreciate you beyond words. Your faithfulness in prayer and giving to this ministry mean more than words can say. I pray for you often!
